SUKARA sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, met a pair of bids leaving the backstretch and inched clear again on the second turn and held gamely under some urging. WARRENS CHINA DOLL stalked just off the rail, bid between horses then outside the winner into the second turn, was not a match for that one thereafter but clearly bested the rest. ATTRACTA between foes early, angled in on the first turn and stalked inside then outside a rival on the second turn and into the stretch and edged a foe for third. POPULAR TRAMP stalked outside, bid three deep leaving the backstretch, fell back some and angled in on the second turn and weakened but just lost the show. BOO WHO WHO chased between rivals then a bit off the rail, continued inside on the second turn, came out in the stretchy and lacked the needed rally. CHA CHA LATTE between horses early, chased outside a rival then off the rail, angled inward in the stretch and lacked a response. DUBAI PERFECTO stalked inside, dropped back on the backstretch, was pulled up approaching the second turn and vanned off.
