ROYAL WEEKEND was hustled to the front from along the fence, edged away around the bend, remained inside and tenaciously held under urging. FLOATHRUTHAIR bobbled slightly while breaking alertly, forced the pace outside leader, lost contact on the turn, remained off the fence and went willingly to the wire. LADY ROLL ON stalked while outside rival or slightly off the rail, found the rail entering the stretch, loomed passing sixteenth marker but failed to sustain effort. MISS JUDGED settled outside foe then chased two wide, angled three wide exiting the turn and finished evenly. JIM'S SUCCESS chased early from the inside, shifted out some, raced between rivals into the bend then into the stretch and never threatened. TRIBAL BRAT settled well off the pace and well off the rail, chased three wide then three deep on the turn, remained wide and failed to menace. PARALYZING EYES lagged back early from the inside, saved ground into the stretch but never reached contention. SISTER VOE was forwardly placed early from along the rail, dropped back around the turn and weakened.
