Footnotes

ADDENDUM settled off the pace and off the rail, roused then whittled gap on leaders while three then four wide into the stretch, lugged inward through the drive then gained the front approaching the wire. ROSSI RESERVE contested the early pace outside rival then gained lead, shook loose leaving the backstretch, continued two wide into the stretch, drifted out some in the drive and could not hold the winner. WILD IN THE SADDLE was taken off the early leaders then stalked while slightly off the rail, came three wide into the stretch, steadied off heels off winner passing sixteenth marker and bested others. SHE'S ALL YOURS was off awkwardly and behind the field, came out early, chased three wide most of the way and never seriously threatened. MELANISTIC dueled early from the inside then forced the pace from along the rail, dropped back around the last turn and weakened. EASY GOES BY drifted out into the first turn, came back in, chased pace, saved ground but was no late threat. BROOKLYN ROSE was bit slow to begin, chased early from the inside then along the rail, later angled three wide into stretch and never menaced. SECRET GENIUS reserved early, steadied off heels early on the first turn, came back in, saved ground but never recovered. The stewards conducted an inquiry involving the incident in the stretch but ruled that although WILD IN THE SADDLE did steady off the winner, the incident did not cost WILD IN THE SADDLE a chance at a better placing.
