**Footnotes**

CITY BY THE BAY dueled from the inside early then grabbed command, disposed of SIDE LETTER then powered away into and around the second turn and crushed rivals while given couple of left hand cracks in stretch and under hand encouragement late. HARLINGTON'S ROSE content to lag back early, chased outside foe, angled out some, circled foes while four wide around last turn, remained well off the fence and was along for the place. PERCHED unhurried leaving the gate, crossed over to secure the rail, chased inside, rallied inside KANTINA KOWGIRL entering the stretch and was along for third.

WIRED FOR FUN settled off the rail, was forced out into and around the first turn, remained off the fence then four wide into last turn and three wide into the stretch and improved placing. TIME FOR ANGIE was bumped shortly after the break then forced extremely wide into and around the first turn, dropped back, came in some, rallied three then four wide to the stretch and finished gamely. PAY THE DEBT drifted out into the first turn, later came back in some, gained the rail and lacked needed response. ANALEMMA was forwardly placed early, chased three wide then was caught three deep into second turn, between rivals around that bend and weakened. KANTINA KOWGIRL showed brief early foot then was taken off the leaders, stalked from the inside, came two wide into the lane and also weakened. SIDE LETTER bumped with inside rival early then showed good early foot and contested the pace outside the winner, stalked pacesetter in middle stages but dropped back and weakened from between horses. MEINERTZHAGENI was bit hard to load, stalked off the rail to first turn, forced to steady sharply off heels of PAY THE DEBT early on the first turn, came out further on that turn, dropped back rapidly and was pulled up on the backstretch. The stewards conducted an inquiry involving the first turn incident and disqualified PAY THE DEBT for drifting out and causing interference and made her unplaced.
