Footnotes

RALPHY GIRL sped to the lead past the stands, opened up a clear advantage leaving the first turn, maintained the advantage into the stretch and remained clear to the wire under steady handling. BROUGHT TO JUSTICE saved ground around the first turn, chased on the inside down the backstretch and inside a rival around the second turn, remained on the wood through the lane and was up for the place. SHARP BELLA chased the pace outside a rival around the first turn and down the backstretch, was closest to the winner entering the stretch, could not gain the needed ground and lost the place on the wire. BRITENESS chased inside a rival around the first turn and down the backstretch, could not keep pace with that foe around the second turn, came into the lane three wide and weakened in the final furlong. YALETOWN chased the pace off the rail and outside a rival around the second turn, came into the stretch between horses and lacked the needed rally in the final furlong. DANCE LITTLE ANGEL was unhurried past the stands, chased a bit off the rail down the backstretch, remained near the wood in the lane and did not threaten.
