Footnotes

LIVE THE FORTH sped into the first turn between horses, dueled inside a rival down the backstretch and into the stretch, responded when challenged in upper stretch and gradually drew away from her pace rival in the final furlong. TORRE ITALIANA showed good early speed three wide into and around the first turn, dueled outside the winner down the backstretch and around the second turn, could not match strides with her pace rival in the final furlong but held the place. RAMBLE ON ROSE saved ground around the first turn, stalked inside a rival down the backstretch, remained on the wood around the second bend, came out for the drive and held the show. SMIL'N FROM ABOVE chased on the outside throughout the journey and lacked the needed rally in the lane. QUEEN OF THE HILL dueled inside a three horse spread into the first turn, dropped back on the rail entering the backstretch and weakened. DECOY was off a bit slowly, chased outside a rival around the first turn, went into the second turn three deep, weakened around the bend and gave way in the lane.
