Footnotes

POSHSKY content to chased while bit off the fence then along the rail, launched rally leaving second turn, reeled in leader into second bend, roared past that rival passing three-sixteenths marker and accelerated away. TIZ FUTURITY lagged back early from the inside, saved ground to the second turn, angled out, rallied three then four wide into the stretch and drew away late to prove second best. MR. SATISFACTION settled while bit off the rail, raced between rivals or two wide, came out slightly in the stretch and was along late for third. FLY HIGH was sent to the front then grabbed sizeable cushion with one lap left, continued with uncontested lead into final backstretch, had cushion shrink into and on the final turn, was overtaken and weakened in final eighth.

DICKERY DO angled over the gained rail, was closest pursuer from the inside into final backstretch, dropped into and around last turn and faded. BUD MATIC settled between rivals then two wide, came out some on the second turn, remained bit wide and failed to threaten late. WILL HE AMAZE was taken to the rail early, chased from the inside, saved ground throughout and never reached contention. ANCIENT STONE settled outside foe, chased three wide early, remained wide and lacked any late response. HOUDINI'S MAGIC was off slow and inward, also chased from the inside, saved ground for most of the trip and failed to menace. ALKARAY stalked three then four wide to the second turn, dropped back and also weakened. CYPRIOT gained stalking position early from between rivals, continued three wide into the second turn, came in some, dropped back readily then was pulled up in the stretch and walked off.
