RUBY PUMPS stalked pacesetter while bit off the rail, remained two wide into second turn, turned pressure on leader on final backstretch, roused into final bend, forged to the front, quickly cleared on two wide path and safely held under vigorous handling. TOOMANYTOMATOES tracked pace while outside rival, remained on two then three wide path through one lap, continued on three wide path into stretch and cleared to prove second best. CHANGETHECHANNEL stepped to the front and rated while well in hand from the inside, resisted when challenged three-eighths from wire, could not go with winner on final turn, dropped back and lasted for third. CATHY'S CRUNCHES chased from along the rail and saved ground through two turns, was taken off the fence, raced three wide into last turn and did not threaten. LITTLE EMILY settled while outside rival, continued on two wide path most of the trip, came out some entering the stretch and never reached contention. GOING FOR A SPIN reserved from along the rail and raced on the inside to final turn, shifted off the fence but was no late factor. CANDREA stalked from along the fence, continued inside, dropped back and weakened.
