**Footnotes**

FEAR THE BEARD forced the pace from between rivals into second turn, moved alongside pacesetter then gained slim advantage, inched away entering the stretch then secured the inside through the drive and desperately lasted under strong urging. GO TO THE PULPIT chased while outside rival then three wide to the second bend, continued on same path, loomed three wide around the final turn, remained off the rail, whittled gap on winner in deep stretch and just missed while three abreast at the wire. WARREN'S JOE T. tracked pace while outside rival early then along the inside, continued inside then awaited room entering the stretch, lacked room looking for room along the rail in mid-stretch then moved up between foes, bid nearing the wire but was denied. TITIAN prompted the pace while three wide then three deep on the second turn, loomed outside rival into and around the last turn, continued off the rail then yielded from between foes in final sixteenth. LOW GEAR POWER reserved from along the rail, came off the fence in the middle stages, remained bit wide and bested others. TRUCIAL STATE settled inside then came out leaving first turn, chased three or four wide, dropped back and weakened. GOD OF WAR (BRZ) stepped to the front and set pressured pace along the rail into second turn, resisted while under asking to stay close, was in tight along the fence into last turn, dropped back and weakened. A DAY AWAY chased along the inside, remained on the rail, dropped back leaving second bend and gave way.
