Footnotes

BIGBARI caught four wide into first turn, angled in some, advanced while slightly off the rail then inside WARREN'S OPERATOR on the final turn, came out bit, roared past leader and powered away. LOVMEISTER three wide early, angled over early on the backstretch, made bold move along the rail, reached front past three-eighths marker, edged away on the final turn but had little resistance for the winner. RIO GOOD chased while outside foe early, fanned three wide early on the first turn, raced off the rail, advanced some to second turn, came four wide into the lane and closed late on the runner-up. SUPERSONIC HEAT reserved from along the rail then drifted some on the first turn, moved up from the inside to the second turn and finished evenly. HEY YUP was taken off the leaders nearing the first turn, was rank then drifted out into first turn, dropped well back, saved ground into the stretch and found his best stride late. WARREN'S OPERATOR showed good early foot from between foes then gained control into backstretch, set pace from slightly off the fence, relinquished command past three-eighths marker and weakened. BACKSTREET BOSS caught four deep into first turn, stalked from off the rail, continued on same path to the second bend and also weakened. COVER TRICK close up while three wide early then tracked the leader while on same path, came out further leaving last turn and also faded. WARREN'S VANWINKLE dueled early from the inside then stalked from along the fence, dropped back and gave way.
