NATIONBUILDER settled off the for the first two miles, started to pick up the pace three jumps from home, gaining on the leaders with every stride after the second last with SALUDA SAM, dueled briefly then drew clear. SALUDA SAM was never far off the pace, stalked the front runner with a mile to go, got to the lead after second last jump and had a slight advantage jumping the last but was no match for the winner.. FARNDALE was allowed to settle off the pace, started gaining ground with a mile to go, was in striking distance going to the last then flattened out. HONOUR EMBLEM trailed the field through out and fell way back but still finished the race. FOUR SCHOOLS (IRE) took command from the start, gave up the lead after the second last but was still in contention when he fell at the last jump. NONDO was through after two miles started to fall back and left course after the third last jump.
