GOOD REQUEST was aloud to settle in the second flight, moved boldly around the top turn after jumping the second last, was right there three wide jumping the last and drew clear at the wire. BEST ALIBI (IRE) was rank from the start and opened up a commanding lead, he was coming back to the field going down the back side for the final time, had a length advantage jumping the last but could not hold off the winner. ZOZIMUS was running second and well in front of the rest of the field trying not to give up to much distance to the leader, gained significant ground on the leader in the final turn, but had no response from the last fence home. STRAIGHT TO IT was in contention until the last jump but failed to respond. DUGAN was through after a mile and no factor here. DEVIL'S PREACHER was racing in the back and fell over the second last jump.
