**Footnotes**

BE CERTAIN was never far back in the early goings, found room along the rail for a bid to reach the lead at the top of the stretch, dueled with CR'S DEPUTY in the lane and was clear late. C R'S DEPUTY was always close while racing on the outside, moved up to duel with BE CERTAIN in the lane but could not match strides with that one and finished second best. MULTIE COLORED raced between foes early, was bumped at the last fence by COUPE DE VILLE when that one came in, but finished well. COUPE DE VILLE raced towards the rear from early on, made a late run, came in slightly to bump MULTIE COLORED at the last fence, was straightened and found his stride. MECKLENBURG showed speed in the opening mile then tired. HOT RIZE was never a factor. TANK ZONE rushed up early to press the pace then faded. ALL RACES AT THE COLONIAL CUP ARE HAND TIMED.
