SERMON OF LOVE rated in the early goings from the inside, closed the distance with a late rush and was clear late. SLIP AWAY raced close to the leaders early, moved up to press the pace near the midway point while racing outside, gained a slight advantage on the final turn but was outfinished. HAGGARD pressed the pace for a mile, took the lead entering the stretch, and faded. FIRE ISLAND JET was well back most way, then improved his position with a late run. ED'S EMPIRE raced towards the rear from the outset, raced evenly to the stretch, then advanced with a mild response. DESERT VIGIL set a pressured pace for two miles, then tired in the late stages. FERSHAW raced near mid pack to the lane, then failed to rally. CLASS DEPUTY raced close up in the opening stages from the inside, gave ground steadily then retreated when asked for a response. TAX RULING was outrun. APPALACHIAN raced four or five on the opening turn, stayed wide throughout, then tired. ALL RACES AT THE COLONIAL UP ARE HAND TIMED.
