SUNSHINE NUMBERS raced just off the leaders, assumed command at the third last jump and drew off after jumping the last fence. EAGLE BEAGLE was on the pace all the way and was second best here. MOTEL AFFAIR was within striking distance jumping the last, but failed to sustain bid. DUBAI SUNDAY (JPN) ran evenly and was no threat here. HENRY'S HERO got into contention after a mile then fell back. THE EDITOR was through after a mile and a half. BOLD TURN trailed the field and was no factor. BRANDS HATCH had brief speed and was through after a mile, jump third last fence badly and pulled up. FOGCUTTER raced back of the pack and fell at the ninth jump. CUSE was getting outrun through the stretch for the first time and was pulled up before the ninth fence. MON VILLEZ (FR) lost rider at the third jump. FABI'S LEGACY refused to start.
