Footnotes

SUDDENLY SILVER stalked the leaders three deep as part of the second flight, made a steady advance in that path on the bend to challenge, took over nearing the furlong marker and went clear under firm encouragement. HE'S NO PIKER was urged to secure terms with a rival on the pace, prompted the tempo along the rail, edged forward to a narrow advantage nearing upper stretch but proved no match for the winner. BORN RUNNING tracked the leaders along the rail in the second flight racing into the turn, angled out entering upper stretch but had no final response. TEZ AZADI was switched out early, raced four wide to upper stretch and flattened out. TRICKY TITAN worked his way inside racing to the turn while unhurried but offered no rally. MISTER BROWN broke sharply, flashed brief pace outside rivals in the opening stages but quickly gave way. MATT'S QUEST was through early.
