ANNE SHIRLEY went quickly clear of the field, held sway to upper stretch and widened her advantage to the end while being kept to pressure. BECKY'S ANGEL stalked the pacesetter between foes in second flight, made a brief challenge to the winner nearing upper stretch, couldn't maintain terms with that foe but gamely held second. SENTIMENTAL CHARM, unhurried racing four wide between foes early, made steady progress into the lane and continued willingly to the end. TWO DIME LIMIT, bumped from both sides and pinched back at the start, recovered to make some belated progress along the inside in the closing stages. BLUMIN BEAUTY was a brief factor outside foes, but faded steadily in the drive. GRACIOUS HALO broke out, bumped TWO DIME LIMIT, was settled along the inside and offered no rally. WINGS ARE THE WAY worked her way inside tracking the pace but lacked the necessary late response. ISLE SEE YOU LATER was never a factor. NIGHT TRIBUTE broke inwards bumping TWO DIME LIMIT, was quickly righted to stalk the pacesetter racing to the bend but retreated in the drive.
