FOR COLTS AND GELDINGS, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD WHICH ARE REGISTERED MINNESOTA BREDS. Free to nominate, \$250 to pass the entry box and \$250 additional to start, with \$35,000 guaranteed (\$20,250 from Canterbury Park and \$10,000 from the Minnesota Breeders' Fund), of which \$21,000 to the owner of the winner. All other purse monies paid corresponding with purse schedule in Condition Book. Weights: Three-year-olds, 116 lbs; Older, 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$15,000 twice in 2010 allowed 3 lbs; \$15,000 in 2010, 5 lbs; \$10,000 in 2009-2010, 7 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in allowances). HIGH WEIGHTS PREFERRED (On the Scale). (Winners Preferred). Total earnings in 2009-2010 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to 12 horses. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

Footnotes

BIZET rated between rivals on the lead, dueled through the turn, gained a clear lead at the eighth pole, then drew off under brisk handling to prevail. A STEEL TRAP vied for the early lead three wide, dueled through the turn with rivals, could not go with the winner at the eighth pole and stayed on to be second best. PERFECT BULL broke sharply from the gate and was allowed to settle early, moved up to circle the field three wide, then made a steady gain through the lane to get up for the show outside. NOMOREWINEFOREDDIE broke a step slowly, moved up to loop the field four wide through the turn, then was outfinished late. BET YOUR BOOTS chased the early pace off the rail, dueled through the turn while gaining a striking position, then flattened out in the lane. JACK AND MAX fractious in the gate, was mid pack and inside, gained a striking position through the turn, then weakened in the stretch. SUDDENLY SILVER pinched back in the early stages was forced to steady slightly off heels into the turn, then was boxed in the stretch. WALLY'S CHOICE improved his position. TRICKYVILLE DEW had a wide trip. SIR TRICKY showed little. MUSICAL DIAMONDS set the early pace on the rail, dueled through the turn, then stopped.
