### Footnotes

WHO LET THE CAT IN was hustled to the lead inside foes in the opening quarter, went well clear in upper stretch and held sway to the end under pressure. JUSTA STREAK was allowed to settle in the opening quarter racing off the inside, advanced four wide on the bend to challenge, couldn't gain terms with the winner but proved best of the others. BLUMIN WON, allowed to settle in early stages, angled inside nearing upper stretch and steadily improved his position on the rail. VANILLA SCOOP tracked the pacesetter as part of the second flight along the inside but lacked the needed late response. TIE ROD broke sharply, tracked the pacesetter racing four wide to the turn, continued between foes but gave way nearing the lane. WHAM tracked the pace between foes in second flight and gave way after a half. I SPY WOLFIE was never a factor.
