Footnotes

SUSIE BLUES, caught in tight quarters at the start, was rushed between foes to strike the front, forged clear midway through the bend and held sway to the end under some right handed pressure. KISSAME, prominent between foes, raced with the pacesetter to the turn, couldn't stay on terms with that foe through the bend but was clearly second best. PICKIN THE PACE, allowed to settle in the opening stages while being guided to the inside, split foes leaving the turn and continued to improve position to the end. MOON SINGER, close up early, stalked just off the leaders racing into the turn but weakened after a half. BELLE AMERICAN tracked the leaders in midpack but dropped out nearing upper stretch. T J CASEY was caught wide and never proved any factor. GRITTY MADAM tracked the leaders unhurried along the rail and soon faded from contention. BRIEFLY broke slowly and raced wide throughout.
