MARATHON MOON was unhurried early, raced towards the inside throughout and finished gamely to get up under steady handling. NO CROSSING LANE pressed the pace, gained a narrow lead but couldn't hold off the winner in the final stages. KING OF RHYTHM settled off the early pace, moved up six wide into the upper stretch and made a good late gain. ALREADY THERE stalked the pace, raced five wide in the stretch and had no final winning bid. BACKTRACK was slow early, raced four deep and never was a serious threat. PATRIATE showed good speed from the inside and faded. SEATTLE SAL settled off the early pace, raced seven deep in the lane and never was a factor. SWISS G'S stalked the pace and tired.
