THIRD RAIL was allowed to settle early, moved up four wide in the stretch and finished gamely to prevail under all out pressure. GENERAL LAFAYETTE dropped back early, saved ground throughout and finished gamely in the final stages to just miss. CACHEMASSA CREEK pressed the pace while racing three deep and weakened a bit in the drive. SWIFT PROGRESS settled off the early pace, moved up six wide into the upper stretch and never was a real threat. TOAST IN THE PARK stalked the pace and weakened. MISCHIEF MO failed to sustain a bid. BANKER'S WAY was slow early, raced four deep and never menaced. THATS RAY'S TIGER set all the pace from the inside and tired readily the final eighth of a mile.
