Free to nominate, \$250 to pass the entry box and \$250 additional to start, (a supplemental nomination of \$1,000 will be accepted at the time of entries which will include all fees) with \$50,000 guaranteed, (includes \$15,000 from the Mystic Lake Enhancement Fund) of which \$30,000 to the owner of the winner. All other purse monies paid corresponding with purse schedule in Condition Book. Weights: Three-year-olds, 118 lbs; Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$15,000 twice in 2012 allowed 3 lbs; \$15,000 in 2012 5 lbs; \$10,000 in 2012 7 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in allowances). HIGH WEIGHTS PREFERRED. (On the scale). (Winners Preferred). Total earnings in 2012-2013 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to 12 horses. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee.

A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Friday, May 10 with 27. (S)

Footnotes

HELISKIER set all the pace from the inside and drew off in the final stages to be well clear under a steady hand ride. FREEDOM FIRST stalked the pace from the outside, raced four wide in the stretch and was no match for the winner. BOBBLE DOIT was off a step slow, raced towards the inside and had no final winning bid. SPEAKFROMYOURHEART stalked the pace, took aim at the leader through the far turn and weakened in the latter stages while racing three wide. SAMENDRA was off slowly, raced towards the inside and never was a factor. EURASIAN showed little. WILLOW PARISH was hustled from the inside and tired. SUGAR BUSINESS failed to menace.
