Footnotes

JOBAG broke outwards brushing a rival, was hustled clear of the field, made the pace racing just off the rail into the turn and held her advantage under steady pressure. VENGEFUL VICKY angled sharply to the rail just after the break to stalk the pacesetter, pressed inside that foe into the lane but came up second best. RACEY STACEY stumbled badly at the start, raced unhurried to the turn, swung outside foes leaving the bend and improved position in the drive. RED HOT KISS, void of early speed, came inside tiring rivals along the rail to gain position late. CORKING TULIP stalked between foes in the second flight, made a brief bid outside the winner but flattened out through the lane. DANCIN REGIMENT tracked the pacesetter five deep to the turn, leaned in, bumped BECKY'SMAORIMPACT, then emptied out leaving the turn. MISS TWO BAGGER tracked the leaders along the inside for a half and dropped out nearing lane. BECKY'SMAJORIMPACT, brushed by the winner at the start, raced four wide between foes while in tight quarters, was bumped approaching the turn and gave way abruptly.
