ELEMENTARY MY DEAR, forwardly placed on the rail from the break, pressed the pace inside foes racing into upper stretch, edged clear nearing midstretch and maintained his advantage under pressure. I'M L W tracked the first flight along the inside racing to the turn, came through inside rivals nearing upper stretch to challenge inside the leader, closed the gap late but was always second best. C. J. BLARG, allowed to settle in early stages while being guided inside foes, made steady progress racing into the bend, swung out three deep in upper stretch and was gaining well to the end. TU TU MON was hustled from the break to join the pace four deep, pressed in that path to upper stretch and weakened late. LOWMAN, prominent between foes from the break, duelled for command into the turn and gave way in the drive. PINE SIREN was settled along the inside on the backstretch, angled out entering the lane and passed some tiring rivals. KITTY LITTER, unhurried racing well off the inside to the turn, never gained contention. TAPESTRY IN MOTION, off a bit slowly, never menaced. DALE'S CRUSADER showed little. DOUBLE SNOW was a brief factor outside foes racing in second flight but gave way after a half. MAN OF MEN, close up three deep between foes racing to the turn, retreated early.
