Footnotes

KNOW NO SOMERSET gained a clear lead soon after the start, increased his lead through the stretch and lasted. SUPREMO STRUCKGOLD well placed and three wide, bid on that path into the stretch, then closed willingly to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. DISTINCTIVE SAINT tracked the early pace on the rail, raced boxed through the turn, then lacked the needed late kick. C J MAMAS BOY second flight and off the rail, steadied slightly into the turn while remaining in contention, then had a mild stretch rally to get up for a share. SUPREME GHOST stalked the early pace outside, then weakened in the drive. BALL AND CRANE ran evenly. TRICKY SKY PILOT improved his position. VIC THE KICK well placed in the early going, had no rally. HAIL CHASER was through after a half. BEAUASODA was no factor. CODE READY was outrun.
