NIX OF KIN void of speed, moved to contention through the turn, angled out to bid on the two path into the stretch, was bumped by a rival, then drifted in under left hand urging and drew off late. WINTPAY well placed and outside, moved up through the turn, challenge for and gain a short lead in the stretch, then could not go with the winner late and held the place safe. KELLEYS MARQ tracked the early pace inside, angled out to bid three wide into the stretch, then drifted in through the lane and lacked a late kick. LAUNCH N LUKE void of speed and outside, came widest into the stretch and got up for a share. LUXURY AND GLITTER never far back and inside, angled out in the stretch, bumped a rival, then ran evenly. JOLICOEUR ran evenly. THE THIRD GUY set the early pace and had no rally. NORTHERN EDITION showed little. OLD IRON well placed, faltered. AVENGEIT was through after a half. CLUNY was never involved. DOCTOR RUN RUN was no factor.
