Footnotes

PYOTE well placed off the rail, gained a striking position at the three sixteenth pole, then split horses while making a steady gain to edge ahead in the final strides. MALAWI stalked the early pace off the rail, dueled through the turn and gained a clear lead into the stretch, then veered out repeatedly through the lane and was outfinished. RIO BRILLA rushed up to take the early lead, dueled with MALAWI through the turn, could not stay with that one and was not threatened for the show spot. CATCH A STAR void of speed and outside, passed a tiring rival through the lane to gain a share. JADE'S TIGER well back and on the rail, steadied slightly into the turn, then had no rally. GOOD TIMES TWEENUS was through after a half.
