WINNINGDANCER, caught outside foes racing three or four deep racing to the first turn, made a steady advance to gain a tracking position while saving some ground on the second bend, continued with a steady rally to challenge three deep entering upper stretch, then took over and went clear under firm encouragement. SILLY BARBIE broke outwards, was urged to dispute the lead along the rail racing to the backstretch, dueled for command into upper stretch, couldn't contain the winner but held resolutely for the place. SKINNY LEGS N ALL went up from the break to join the pace outside foes four wide racing to the first bend, angled inwards a bit nearing the backstretch to press a rival, continued to challenge that foe to upper stretch, had no response for the winner's challenge and was outfinished for the place late. LIL'S BUTTER CUP was settled saving ground in early stages, then continued evenly to the lane. QUEEN OFTHE GALAXY was urged to secure a forward placing between foes racing into the first turn, tracked the leaders as part of the second flight, then faded steadily from contention on the far turn. MY CHICAGO ROSE, caught in tight quarters at the start, was settled into stride and never gained contention. ANGEILA'S DANCER never seriously menaced. SASS was urged to contention between foes in the opening quarter, then gave way abruptly after a half.
