VINI VIDI VINCI broke a step slowly and was well back and inside, gained a striking position through the second turn, then came through inside of rivals into the stretch, drew off under brisk handling. FARE CIELO set the early pace on a long lead well off the rail, drifted out into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. MOGADISHU well back and three wide, looped rivals four wide through the second turn, fanned five wide to bid into the stretch and had a mild gain. JACK'S ROMA well back and off the rail, came four wide to bid into the stretch, then got up for a share. PROGRAM MANAGER stalked the early pace outside and faded in the drive. QUICK SCORE tracked the early pace inside and tired.
