MAKING A RACQUET just up to set the pace four wide, gained a clear lead through the turn, then shook off a challenge from DEAR HRISHI and lasted while all out. DEPECHE well placed and three wide, moved up and angled out through the turn, fanned five wide to bid into the stretch, then had a steady gain and missed in the final strides. LOBSTER MOBSTER tracked the early pace off the rail, came through inside of rivals at the quarter pole, closed willingly to gain the show while no threat to the top two. DEAR HRISHI well placed and off the rail, steadied through the turn, took back and angled out to bid five wide into the stretch, then closed willingly but lacked the needed late kick. SILENT COPY passed tiring rivals. TAPITINTIME improved her position. STILLWATER STORM well placed and on the rail, steadied through the turn and faded. RUNAWAY GREY LADY broke a step slowly and showed little. SAPPHIRE SUE showed little. MISS ABBEY MARIE was a brief factor. HONOUR THY LADY trailed the field.
