TAKEMETOMARK, bumped at the start, recovered quickly to track the pacesetter between foes in the second flight, then produced a sustained response entering upper stretch to gain terms with the leader in the final strides and edge that foe under firm left handed encouragement. MAN UP went readily to the fore while angling over, dictated the tempo along the inside while opening a commanding margin and just failed to contain the winner. CHASE ME, unhurried along the inside early, split foes racing into upper stretch and improved his position to the end. JR HILLS was slow into stride, then made some belated progress in the drive. NOT SO TIMELESS was allowed to settle in the opening stages and never gained striking distance. TIOGA CROSSING chased the pacesetter along the rail to upper stretch, then gave way nearing the lane. SHADY GHAZI ducked in, bumped the winner at the start, was righted to track the pace three wide, then gave way after a half. EMAIL ALERT ducked out at the start, was a brief factor racing five wide to the turn and gave way.
