Footnotes

GLADDENS CHOICE hesitated at the start, recovered to gain a tracking position in the second flight while being switched outside racing to the bend, continued with a steady advance to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch, took charge and went clear under firm encouragement. WEBBER tracked just off the leaders near the inside in the opening stages, came through inside foes to secure second in the drive but was no match for the winner. BIG BURGER raced unhurried outside foes in the opening quarter, then steadily improved his position to late stages. THE QUINNSTER was urged to the fore along the inside, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave way late. ANDY PERSEVERED, close up between foes in the opening stages, was held up tracking the leaders nearing the bend, angled out to briefly challenge four deep nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed late response. HEADS UP PENNY was allowed to settle in the opening quarter and never gained striking distance. CRANKY GATOR prompted the pace three wide racing to the bend, pressed outside the winner to upper stretch and emptied out.
