POMEROY GIRL vied for the early lead inside, angled out and moved up to challenge through the second turn, gained a clear lead, then held that margin through the lane while being kept to the task. CHAMP LAILA void of speed, moved up through the second turn, angled out in the stretch and closed fast to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. VIA DI ROMA well back and inside, moved to position on the two path through the second turn, came three wide to bid into the stretch, then made a steady gain to the final furlong and ran evenly late. GRACIAS tracked the pace on the inside, angled out to bid just outside the pace and ran evenly through the lane. GLORIOUS DESTINY set the early pace off the rail and faded after a half. LITTLE ZEE showed little. VAULTS LAST SISTER was a brief factor.
