WILD IN RIO showed good early speed and held gamely to draw clear under strong pressure. SOUPER FOUR pressed the pace from the outside and finished second best. BLUES EDGE was unhurried early, raced three deep in the lane and made a mild late gain. LUCKY GEM stalked the pace, saved ground and had no final run. ENDURING ANGEL stalked the pace, raced four wide into the upper stretch and never was a factor. CINDER ELLIE was slow early, raced five wide in the lane and had no response. SIFTEN GOLD NUGGET settled off the early pace, raced five wide into the lane and never was a factor. USANA stalked the pace along the inside and tired. TRIPPIN' TRICKS failed to menace.
