Footnotes

DONT MAKE ME MAD sprinted to a clear lead, was never challenged and held his margin under steady handling. BIG CAL tracked the pace on the inside, raced boxed through the turn, angled out for clear racing room and could not match the winner. BREEZY POINT well back and off the rail, moved to position on the two path through the turn, altered out in the stretch for clear racing room and closed fast to get up for the show. SAMENDRA stalked the early pace outside, gained a striking position through the turn, bid three wide into the stretch, then ran evenly the final furlong. GORDON DRIVE well back and off the rail, gained a striking position through the turn, came four wide to bid into the stretch, then lacked the needed late kick. GOLD COUNTRY CAT second flight and off the rail, gained position through the turn, bid three wide into the stretch, drifted in and weakened. CLAY W. WOODSTOCK showed little. CAMP MINISTER gained position inside and had no stretch rally. YOUTHFUL AMBITION was no factor.
