Footnotes

JACK'S STORM sprinted to the front from the break, angled in sharply while dictating the pace between foes into the turn, then held his advantage to the end under stout left handed pressure. ROYAL TRAMP went quickly to the fore to prompt the pace along the rail, continued grudgingly inside the winner to the final stages but couldn't best his rival. I'M REGISTERED angled inwards while quickly drawing on terms with the pacesetter, forced the tempo three deep through the turn but was outfinished by the top pair. DIPLOMATIC CORPS tracked the leaders unhurried along the rail, swung outside to race four deep in the lane and continued to make a mild, late gain. SILVER ZIPPER exchanged bumps with FIVE STAR DEPUTY at the start, raced between foes as part of the second flight through the turn but lacked a final bid. THATSUSINTHEOLBEAN, allowed to settle while racing five wide on the backstretch, lacked a serious rally. J W JET tracked the pace four wide between foes but never gained striking position. FIVE STAR DEPUTY exchanged bumps with a rival at the start, was forced in a bit by the winner just after the break, chased the leaders along the inside for three furlongs and then gave way. SHINNECOCK was void of early pace and soon trailed.
