ZUELLA angled to the inside chasing the pacesetter into the turn, came out entering upper stretch to challenge that foe, then responded to pressure to wrest command in the final stages under firm handling. I'M FEELING LUCKY was hustled to the lead racing inside foes, set the pace to upper stretch while gaining a clear advantage but couldn't fend off the winner in the final stages. YIPPY YIPPY YAY was caught five wide chasing the pace into the turn, continued to make steady progress outside foes and improved his position to the end. BARFLY ZIPPER broke sharply, chased the pacesetter three wide between foes and faded in the drive. MISS GOLD BAR flashed brief pace four wide racing into the bend, then gave way nearing the lane. STORMY MARKET tracked the leaders along the inside, saved ground to upper stretch but never gained contention. POWER MONGER hesitated at the break, lost position and never menaced thereafter. RIBOT'S RIFT broke awkwardly and never gained contention. SUES THUNDER TRICK bolted on the turn and quickly dropped out. SUE'S N PROMISE was steadied in close quarters just after the start and trailed the field to the lane.
