TETON MOTEL stalked the early pace outside, moved up to challenge through the turn, gained a short lead into the stretch, then drew off in the under hand urging. CALL ME CAPTAIN broke a step slowly and was allowed to settle, moved up inside through the turn, then came through inside of rivals into the stretch and closed well to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. DON'T RUSH JUSTICE well placed and inside, moved up through the turn, angled out to bid three wide, then lacked the late kick needed. COWBOY LUKE never far back, moved up through the turn, angled out to bid four wide, then ran evenly the final furlong. BETTE'S AFTERSHOCK passed tiring rivals. A LITTLE STORM KEY set the early pace off the rail and faltered. CLEARLYALUCKYGUY was never involved. WENTZVILLE MAN was no factor. JAYHAWK INDEED was through after a half.
