FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. Free to nominate, \$250 to pass the entry box and \$250 additional to start, (A supplemental nomination of \$1,500 will be accepted at the time of entries which will include all fees.) with \$35,000 guaranteed, of which \$21,000 guaranteed to the owner of the winner. All other purse monies paid corresponding with purse schedule in Condition Book. Weights: Three-year-olds, 118 lbs; Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$15,000 twice in 2012 allowed 3 lbs; \$15,000 in 2012 5lbs; \$10,000 in 2011-2012, 7 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in allowances). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Thursday, May 17 with 36. (If management deems it inadvisable to run this race on the Turf, it will be run at a distance of 5 Furlongs on the main track.).

Footnotes

SANTO GATO stalked the pace on the inside, angled to the outside of that one and moved up through the turn, bid just outside the pace setter, then took command and held under steady pressure. RICHMOND mid pack and outside, looped rivals three wide through the turn, came four wide to bid into the stretch, then closed willingly to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. HUMBLE SMARTY well placed and between rivals, gained position through the turn on the two path, came three wide to bid and ran evenly in the lane. SILVER MAGNUS well placed and inside, gained position through the turn, was blocked into the stretch, waited, got through, then lacked the needed late kick. INCLUDING GOLD improved his position. BROAD BEACH was never involved. JUST JEBICAH was no factor, inside. NO PEACE AT ALL set the early pace off the rail and stopped.
