Footnotes

SOUL SINGER was rated in hand racing just off the pace along the inside to the backstretch, switched out on the far turn to launch a three wide bid for command, then edged clear of ERINN AND AARON through the lane under firm encouragement. The latter was reserved racing off the inside to the backstretch, angled to the inside while drawing into striking distance approaching the far turn, bid inside the winner for command leaving the midway point of the second turn, drifted out a bit in upper stretch and proved only second best in the drive. CAPTAIN DUDE was settled along the inside in the opening half, steadied momentarily when caught in tight quarters midway through the far turn, switched out a bit nearing the lane and continued to improve his position. POWERFUL PEPPER raced unhurried in early stages, saved ground throughout while making some mild progress after six furlongs but had no final response. EL INTOCHABLE bounded clear of the field into the first turn, held sway to the far turn, but gave way once headed. PINE SIREN, allowed to settle in the opening stages, raced five wide on the backstretch and continued in that fashion to upper stretch while having little impact. SCOREBOARD was a brief factor between foes but dropped out after a half. DON'TMESSWITHRANDY was a brief factor outside foes, soon faded from contention, was outdistanced in the stretch, then walked off under his own power.
