MRS. BEERMAN, off a step slowly, made steady progress along inside to gain striking distance racing into the bend, came out leaving the sixteenth marker and collared WATCH ME CLOSELY to be up in time. The latter raced in close quarters at the start, made steady progress between foes racing through the turn, bid three deep for command nearing midstretch, gained a narrow advantage between calls late and just missed. EASY GRINDER, allowed to settle well off the leaders while being guided to the rail, came off the inside in upper stretch and split foes in a belated effort. BONNIE BE QUICK chased the pacesetter along the rail into the turn, came inside that foe to challenge in upper stretch but was outfinished in the final stages. MAKE MINE VIOLETS sprinted clear of the field soon after the start, held sway to upper stretch but faltered in the final three sixteenths. DESERT STOP IN broke inwards, was righted to track the leaders from the outside to the bend but lacked the needed late response. BUCK'S LUCKY STAR chased the pacesetter three deep into the bend but emptied out after a half. MISS STIPENDS flashed brief pace and stopped. OLGA S was never a factor. MINNESOTA PROSPECT was outrun.
