**Footnotes**

TUFFY IS GOOD, bumped at the start by BROTHER O MINE, was quickly righted to gain a stalking position racing just outside that foe to the bend, wrested command nearing midstretch and edged clear under firm encouragement. TEZ TARAN was allowed to settle racing off the inside in the opening stages, split foes near the inside entering upper stretch and made steady progress to the end while always second best. ABIT O IRISH tracked the pace outside foes, raced four wide into the turn to upper stretch and continued well enough to earn a share. BROTHER O MINE broke out, bumped the winner, was righted to set the pace near the inside racing to the bend, couldn't match the winner after five furlongs and gave way in the drive. CLASSIC TANAGER chased the leaders off the inside, angled inwards entering the turn and gave way after a half. GOTASHOTOFGOLD never gained striking position.
