Footnotes

CARLA SPARKLES was taken in hand soon after the break to rate off the leaders while outside foes on the first turn, made steady progress to gain striking distance after five furlongs, split foes three wide to challenge leaving the far bend, took over in mid stretch and widened late under firm hand urging. ROSE BY A NOSE, forwardly placed from the outset, pressed the pace three wide into the backstretch, edged away midway through the far turn but had no response when confronted by the winner. PARKER COUNTY went quickly to the fore, prompted the pace between foes through the backstretch, then weakened in the last quarter. BYZANTINE DESIGN was briskly roused to the front from the break, chased the leaders along the rail into the backstretch and gave way after a half. MISS TWO BAGGER, allowed to settle along the inside in early stages, saved ground throughout but never produced a serious rally. FIGHTINFORTYNINER ducked out at the start, was reserved well off the pace for a half, then raced wide into the lane while never proving a serious factor. SCHADOW tracked just off the first flight while switching outside those foes on the backstretch, briefly loomed nearing the far turn, but soon faltered after six furlongs.
