COUNCIL OAK well placed and inside, moved up three wide through the second turn, bid on that path into the stretch, then took command and drew off under steady pressure. HERE COMES HENRY mid pack and outside, looped rivals three wide through the second turn, came four wide to bid into the stretch and could not gain the final furlong. CORPORATE CHAPEL rated close up, moved to a striking position on the two path through the second turn, came three wide to bid, then ran evenly in the lane. GRANDPA GEORGE well back and between rivals, moved up on the two path through the second turn, came three wide to bid and improved his position. WHISKEY DECISION passed tiring rivals. WHISKEY DOUBLE set the early pace inside and faded the final furlong. SEEKING THE REWARD vied for the early lead outside, challenged for and gained a short lead, then had no rally. BODACAT was never involved.
