SCOTTS GAP pressed the pace, gained command through the turn and drove clear in the final stages while racing three wide. BAD BOY CHARLIE stalked the pace, raced four deep in the stretch and finished willingly to the wire. DIMEONTHELIME stalked the pace along the inside, raced three deep in the lane and had no late winning bid. CITATIONS HONOR showed good speed along the inside and gave way. GROWLER broke awkwardly, raced five wide into the upper stretch and never was a factor. DUNOON was off slowly and had no response.
