NO. ONE SUSPECT, reserved in early stages, made steady progress between foes racing into the far turn, swung out five wide to come around a drifting rival in upper stretch, then drifted inwards under right handed pressure but continued well enough to secure the lead in time. HUNCH NO TRUMP angled inwards towards the rail after being sent clear racing into the first turn, held sway to late stages and just failed to contain the winner. SEENEMONNA T. V., reserved in hand in the opening quarter, angled inside on the first turn, saved ground to upper stretch, then came through close quarters to make some mild progress late. DUCKS AND PIZZA stalked the pacesetter in second flight to the far turn but lacked the needed closing bid and drifted out in the drive. MOUNT STREET was held up off the leaders while in tight quarters racing to the first turn, saved ground to the lane while unhurried but came up empty in the drive. CARLINS MAGIC SLEW tracked just off the pacesetter along the inside to the far turn, then emptied out in late stages. SUNITI passed only tiring rivals. MOON MYTH gave way after a half. SEATTLE AFTERNOON, unhurried tracking the leaders in midpack to the backstretch, faded steadily in the drive. WHIZ KITTY never seriously menaced.
