### Footnotes

SUGAR STORM well placed and three wide, moved up through the turn, bid on the same path into the stretch and drove clear inside the final furlong. BRASS BOLT allowed to settle outside, moved to position through the turn, fanned widest into the stretch, then closed well to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. TAHKODHA BILL well placed and on the rail, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, then drifted in slightly through the lane while gaining. CASH AT NIGHT vied for the early lead inside, challenged for and gained a short lead into the stretch, then weakened in the drive. PATRIATE set the early pace outside, shortened stride through the lane and tired. ROYAL EXPRESS mid pack and outside, gained position through the turn and had no rally. VINNY V. was never involved.
