### Footnotes

MY PHILLY broke sharply, dictated the tempo to the backstretch and held sway throughout while being kept to pressure. GOLDEN ALPHABET, off a step slowly, tracked the leaders unhurried, split foes leaving the far turn and proved second best. SAVEETA was held up tracking the pace, saved ground to the far turn and improved position in the lane. ROSE FEVER raced unhurried outside foes to the backstretch, made a brief bid four wide leaving the second turn but had no final response. MARCHELLA tracked just off the pacesetter three deep to the far turn, proved no match for that foe leaving the second turn and steadily faded in the drive. SUMINISTER, allowed to settle early, offered no rally. TRUSTING SCOUT was urged to secure a forward placing along the inside, stalked the pacesetter on the rail to the backstretch, checked in traffic after a half and gave way abruptly. REDICULOUSFOREVER tracked the pacesetter between foes in second flight for a half, then emptied out on the far turn.
