CACTUS SON set the early pace outside, shook clear the final furlong, then drew off late under brisk handling. CAGEY mid pack and inside, raced boxed through the second turn while gaining position, waited, split rivals to bid into the stretch, then closed willingly but could not threaten the winner. SALADO TRIBE well back and inside, gained a striking position through the second turn, angled out to bid three wide into the stretch, then lacked the needed late kick. STRATOS stalked the early pace off the rail, moved up three wide through the second turn, came four wide to bid into the stretch and weakened in the late going. HERE COMES HENRY vied for the early lead inside and had no rally. ABOVE THE FRAY was no factor.
